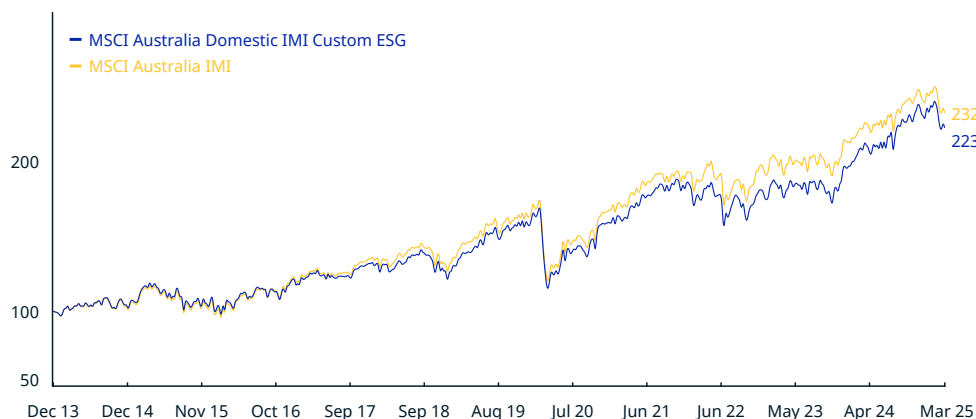


MSCI Australia Domestic IMI Custom ESG Index (AUD)

ESG factors can impact the long-term risk and return profile of investment portfolios. The MSCI Australia Domestic IMI Custom ESG Index is a capitalization weighted index that consists of large and mid-cap companies listed on Australian exchanges. The custom ESG index aims to represent the investable universe with constituent selection based on data from MSCI ESG Research and the ACT Government's business activity exclusions and environmental, social and governance (ESG) requirements. The index is designed to provide a broad, diversified sustainability benchmark with relatively low tracking error to the underlying global developed market equity index.

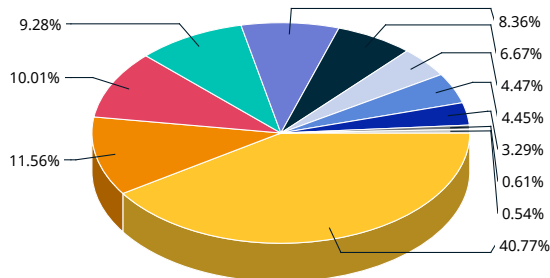
