The MSCI ACWI ex USA Selection Index is a free float-adjusted market capitalization-weighted index designed to represent the performance of companies that are selected from the MSCI ACWI ex USA Index ("Parent Index") based on Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) criteria. These criteria exclude constituents based on involvement in specific business activities, as well as ESG ratings and exposure to Controversies. The Indexes are derived from the MSCI ACWI ex USA Index and aim to achieve sector weights that reflect the sector weights of the corresponding Parent Index. the MSCI ACWI ex USA Selection Index consists of Large and Mid cap companies across 22 of 23 Developed Markets (DM) countries (excluding the US) and 24 Emerging Markets (EM) countries*. The Index construction targets 50% free float-adjusted market capitalization coverage of each Global Industry Classification Standard (GICS®) sector by selecting constituents primarily based on criteria including the ESG rating, and the company's industry-adjusted ESG score. The Index is a member of the MSCI Selection Index series.






