

## What are the MSCI Climate Action Indexes?

MSCI's Climate Action indexes help align global asset owners with an economy-wide climate transition path that suits their investment views. The indexes are abroad, sector balanced, and use a bottom-up approach to select companies in the top half of every gig sector that are effectively tackling their emissions, based on current and forward-looking climate indicators.

Baseline filters remove controversial companies and companies engaged in controversial business activities. And high carbon emitting companies are only eligible if they have an approved Science Based Target.

The indexes are suitable for investors who are looking to finance companies' emission reductions in order to drive change in the real economy.

Augmenting MSCI's Climate Paris Aligned and Low Carbon Target Indexes to capture a broader set of economy wide views of potential climate transition pathways. The result is a series of indexes for global investors who wish to support companies leading the net-zero transition.
