

Introduction

Climate change may well be the defining challenge of the 21st century and, for many institutional investors, addressing climate risk and opportunities has become an ever-more important tenet of the investment process.

Increasingly, governments, businesses and investors worldwide are actively exploring the transition to a low carbon economy.

Why use **climate indexes?**

Climate indexes are part of the toolset investors have at their disposal to incorporate their climate goals in the investment process. We highlight three areas that should be considered:

Governance and oversight Investors are familiar with equity markets. Climate in available for all size segment to similar governance and efficiency by being third p

Investors are familiar with market cap indexes which represent and measure global equity markets. Climate indexes share similarities, such as being rules based, available for all size segments and regions used in asset allocation and are subject to similar governance and maintenance processes. They support objectivity and efficiency by being third party calculated. They differ however by being outcome oriented and the variety of investors preferences or constraints means there is more than one single climate index. For asset owners, a climate index can be designed to develop a climate strategy aligned with climate commitments which can then be vetted by the board. Climate index methodologies can evolve over time to reflect changing objectives. The climate index carries the rules chosen by the asset owner. The indexes can then be licensed to external asset managers.

Portfolio construction

For index investors, climate indexes offer a rules based approach to integrating climate considerations in portfolios. For active investors, climate indexes help measure both the financial and climate performance of a portfolio. Market cap and climate indexes can be used side by side and climate indexes can incorporate preset constraints to manage tracking error or turnover vs the starting universe.

Transparency and communication

Climate indexes facilitate the communication of climate goals internally and externally, and report on progress. A variety of metrics and analytical tools help understand drivers of change in the indexes.
